Alberta Security Licensing

Upon successful completion of SEGI's ONLINE Professional Investigator Training (AIT) course, you must meet all licensing requirements outlined by the Alberta Solicitor General and Ministry of Public Security. The following are the Steps needed to acquire your Alberta Investigator License:

1. [Register now](#) in Alberta's Professional Investigator Training (AIT) program. Once you complete the nine (9) modules, you will complete the online practice exam when you achieve 80% or above you will be able to book an exam at any of our **testing locations across Canada.**
2. Print and complete the [Application Form for Individual License](#) *This version will only be accepted by AB Security Programs - print in CAPITAL LETTERS ONLY
3. Sign both part 5 and 6 of the form
4. Provide one photograph - signed by local police service
5. Provide Police Information and Criminal Record Check (valid for 90 days) - Bring a copy of the Application Form for Individual License, Photo and Identification. Police must sign the back of the photo and conduct the following searches:
 - CPIC
 - Vulnerable Sector
 - Local Database
6. Provide copies of front and back of approved ID with application form
7. Provide proof of approved training (ABST Certificate) with application form
